



SWINA COVID-19 Guidelines

Effective Thursday, September, 16 2021, and in alignment with City of Tempe and CDC guidelines due to the fact Maricopa County is currently considered an area of high transmission for COVID, SWIHA is aligning with state and federal guidelines:

At SWIHA and SOY, we RECOMMEND and ENCOURAGE indoor masking for all teachers, staff, students, and visitors regardless of vaccination status.

To ensure we provide a safe learning environment, all students, staff, and faculty must understand and agree to comply with the following health and safety requirements when on campus.

- Do not come to campus if you are sick or if you have any signs or symptoms of illness or answer yes to any of these questions:
 - Have you had a persistent cough?
 - Have you had a fever of 100.4 F?
 - Have you been around anyone exhibiting these symptoms within the past 14 days?
 - Are you living with anyone who is sick or quarantined?
- Report any confirmed case of covid-19 to your instructor or student services coordinator (student) or Pam Brown (employees).

Any student who is experiencing symptoms of illness, or who is unwilling or unable to comply with any of the above provisions should contact your campus your instructor or Student Services Coordinator as soon as possible.
